



Check List: Green Cleaning Policy

- Reviewed the school building (or District) Green Cleaning procedures.
- Cleaning products used meet the ChildSafe School Guidelines.
- Walk off mats are installed at school entrances.
- Classroom teachers are provided with approved Type I cleaning products and instructed in their use.
- Type II disinfectant products and Type III floor stripping and finishing products are used only as appropriate (by classification) and never when children are present.
- Parents, teachers and staff members are discouraged from bringing into a school facility any product intended to clean, deodorize, sanitize or disinfect.
- All maintenance/custodial staff are informed and trained in the use of green cleaning products.
- A school building (or District) Green Cleaning policy has been adopted and shared with all parents, teachers and staff.
- All cleaning product vendors for the school building (or District) are informed of the policy. The policy is referenced in all new procurement contracts and agreements.
